THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity; and to promote among them all.

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, DO HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.

Part-IV-A FUNDAMENTAL DUTIES

Article 51-A

It shall be the duty of every citizen of India-

- a. To abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- b. To cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom;
- c. To uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- d. To defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so;
- e. To promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- f. To value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture;
- g. To protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life, and to have compassion for living creatures;

About the School

International Indian School Jeddah, formerly known as the Embassy of India School, was founded in 1969. It made a very humble beginning with a limited number of students, staff and infrastructural facilities in a makeshift area. The objective of establishing the school was to impart quality education to the children of Indian nationals residing in Jeddah. With the blessings of the Almighty and constant efforts put in by well-wishers, the school expanded in a phenomenal manner. Currently the school has separate Boys, Girls and KG Sections catering to the educational needs of about 10,500 students.

Curriculum

The school follows the CBSE curriculum. It is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi and prepares the students for All India Secondary School Examination (Std. X) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (Std. XII). The medium of instruction is English.

I. Kindergarten Classes

The children are taught spoken English, Numerals, Hindi and Arabic. Talents in the field of Art, Craft, Singing and Dramatics are developed. To improve the psychomotor domain, children are exposed to various activities such as plasticine moulding, paper folding, fitting blocks to insets etc. The foundation for good handwriting is laid here. The child is exposed to the experience of interacting in a peer group.

II. Primary and Secondary Level

These sections help the children in the all round development of their personality. Equal stress is laid on academics and values. In the classroom, the child is encouraged to comprehend and apply rather than memorize, to enjoy learning, develop regular study habits, think independently with logic and reason. The subjects taught are English, Hindi, Mathematics, EVS, Science, Social Science, Third Languages (Urdu, Arabic, Malayalam, Tamil, Telugu and Kannada), Computer Science, IT, Art and Craft, Physical Education, Saudi Arabian Culture, Islamic Studies, General Arabic, Moral Science, General knowledge, Life Skills etc.

III. Senior Secondary Level

At this level students are prepared for higher learning. Emphasis is laid on strengthening the knowledge in subjects such as English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Applied Mathematics, Biology, Informatics Practices, Computer Science, Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy, History, Geography, Marketing, Physical Education, Home Science, Sociology, Urdu, Arabic, General Arabic, Islamic Civilisation & SAC based on the group opted by the students.

Co-curricular Activities

Besides academics, students have facilities for adequate exposure to the following co-curricular activities: Literary and Cultural, Art, Yoga, Athletics, Cricket, Chess, Badminton, Football, Table Tennis, Volleyball, Basketball, Kho-Kho etc.

Students are divided into four different houses (Red, Green, Blue & Yellow). This system inculcates in the students the spirit of friendly competition, the urge to excel in sportsmanship and leadership qualities.

The school offers ample opportunities for students to develop a sound body which is essential for a sound mind. Various Inter-house and Inter-school sports, Debates, Science Projects and Quiz competitions are conducted periodically.

Scouts & Guides Movement – Creating a Better World.

The purpose of the Movement is to contribute to the development of young people in achieving their full physical, intellectual, emotional, social and spiritual potential as individuals, as responsible citizens and as members of local, national and international communities. To impart life skills to the students the school has a full-fledged 'Bharat Scouts and Guides' unit operating under National Head Quarters-India. The movement now has the enrolment of students from grades I to X, who are guided by trained staff members who have completed training back in India. The units at various levels are as follows:-

Scouts (boys) and Guides (girls): For students of grades VI –X.

Cubs (boys) and Bulbuls (girls): For students of grades III – V

Bunnies (boys & girls): For students of grades I & II.

Within the unit there is gradual advancement of students from one level to the next higher level on completion of the course designed for the timeframe provided by the headquarters.

Library

There are well-stocked libraries with book lending facilities and e-library for students' use. Newspapers, magazines and journals on current affairs, science, sports and education are subscribed.

Laboratories

Well-equipped laboratories for Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Home Science, Geography and Computer Science offer the students avenues for experimentation and learning through practice.

Facilities Offered

Medical Rooms

The school has well equipped medical rooms with the best of first-aid facilities. Each school building has qualified nurses to attend to the medical needs of the students. Any emergency is referred to the nearby hospital/ polyclinic. The students are charged SR.15/- per year for the first-aid facility.

Career Guidance Cell

To provide latest information on courses offered in various institutions of higher learning in India and in other countries, the Career Guidance Cell provides all assistance to the students to choose the right course for their future career. Seminars, contact programmes and conventions are organised to appraise the students of the admission procedures in institutes of higher learning.

School Counselor:

School Counselors are available to assist students at all levels, from primary to Senior Secondary in both the Sections. They act as advocates for students' well-being, and as valuable resources for their educational advancement and listen to students' concerns about academic, emotional or social problems.

School Canteen:

Canteen provides hygienic, healthy & fresh food items to the students.

Security System & CCTV Surveillance:

The safety and security of our children is our priority in school. In order to provide a secure environment for our students, the school has taken the initiative to install CCTV cameras around the school campus to ensure safety at all times. We have well trained security guards who guard the school premises round the clock.

ADMISSION

1. Admission is restricted to children of Indian Nationals only.
2. Registration for new admission will be done on payment of SR. 75.00. Copies of valid Iqama, and passports of the student and both the parents are required. For classes II & above, Transfer Certificate and Progress Card of previous class duly attested by DEO / any appropriate authority are required.
3. Admission is offered on the basis of priority of registration, performance of the candidate in the admission test and in the light of the criteria laid down by the school. The test / interview is conducted according to the schedule given at the time of registration.
4. **Documents in original (passport and Iqama) authenticating the residential status of the pupil and the parents in KSA must be produced at the time of registration for verification. Latest photocopies of the passport and Iqama must be submitted as and when they are renewed.**
5. Student's name and date of birth will be entered in the Admission & Withdrawal Register in words and figures on the basis of entries in the School Leaving Certificate / Passport. No alteration in the name or date of birth or other entries in the Admission & Withdrawal Register will be permitted after the student is formally admitted.
6. Admission will be carried out strictly according to CBSE rules. Students, who do not fulfil the attendance criteria for the academic year, will not be admitted in any case.
7. Admission to grades IX–XII will be considered as provisional. Regularisation of admission will be subject to approval by CBSE.
8. Admission in different streams in Class XI will be subject to availability of seats, the minimum qualifying criteria set by the school and the admission test.

Removal from School Rolls and Re-admission

Fee Default

The name of the student will be automatically removed from the school rolls when the school fee including late fee, if any, is not paid continuously for a period of 02 months.

Re-admission fee of SR. 100.00 will be charged besides recovering other fees and the late fee arrears from the time when the name was struck off the school rolls.

Absence

All students are expected to be regular to the school and do not remain absent without prior approval from the school. **If a student continues to remain absent for a period of one month without genuine reason and prior permission, his / her name will be struck off the rolls.** Submission of leave application does not imply approval unless the leave is granted based on supporting documents. Leave application can be downloaded from the school website.

Cancellation of Transfer Certificate & Re-admission

If a student takes a Transfer Certificate but decides later to continue studies in IISJ, then he/she may be allowed to re-join within 30 working days from the date of issue of TC by paying SR. 100/- as a cancellation charge of the Transfer Certificate.

In case a student takes the Transfer Certificate but wishes to rejoin the same class in the new session , then by virtue of the student still holding the same TC of IISJ, the case may be considered as TC cancellation and readmission and in that case 50% of the normal admission fee will be charged from the student.

In case a student takes TC and joins any other school and comes back with the TC of that School, then the case will be treated as new admission. This and all similar cases not falling in the category of cancellation of TC or readmission will be treated as new admissions. Normal fee for new admission will be charged in all such cases.

Withdrawal from School

1. For withdrawal of students from the school, the parent should notify the school at least 15 days in advance for processing the Transfer Certificate. Transfer Certificate **(TC)** will be issued on clearance of the school dues accrued up to the last day of the month corresponding to the last day of attendance.
2. Students who have not attended the classes since the commencement of a particular academic year will be issued T. C. on clearance of the school dues accrued up to 31st of March of the preceding academic year provided that the T.C is collected within three months from the commencement of the new academic session. For the period beyond this, including for the vacation period, SR 100.00 per month (Subject to a maximum of SR. 200.00) will be levied for issue of TC.
3. Names of students who do not pay the fee for two months or who remain absent for one month without a genuine reason and prior permission from school authorities will be automatically struck off the rolls. If the TC is not collected within 02 months from the date of absence, SR. 100.00 pm (subject to a maximum of SR 200.00) will be levied in addition to the school fee until the month last attended.

If any parent pays the fee for half of the academic year in advance from April 01 to September 30 or October 01 to March 31 then a discount of 5% will be given on the tuition fee only. All other fees except tuition fee will be paid in full.

Fee Payment Schedule

1. All fees are payable on or before the last day of every calendar month.
2. The fee for the month of March should be paid along with the fee for February. All fees payable for the complete academic year for students of KG to VIII, IX & XI should be paid before declaration of the annual exam result. Board going students (X & XII) should pay the fee for February and March before collecting their hall tickets.
3. Late fee will be charged at the rate of SR.1/- for every day of default (for each child whose fee is not paid) after the last day of every month. Default payment for every completed month will be SR. 30/-. After the maximum default of 2 months the student's name will be struck off the rolls.
Re-admission fee of SR. 100.00 will be charged besides recovering other fees and the late fee arrears from the time when the name was struck off the school rolls.
4. Tuition fee will be charged from the beginning of session for the whole academic year. If any part of the fee has been paid in any of the CBSE affiliated schools / equivalently recognized school that part of fees may be condoned on production of authentic documents duly countersigned by the DEO/ R.D CBSE and the fee in such cases may be charged from the date of admission. However all other relevant fee will be charged from beginning of the academic year.
5. Full fee will be charged for all students including every sibling.

Fee Refund Rules

- (i) In case cancellation of admission is made within a month from the date of admission, 80% of the admission fees will be refunded.
- (ii) In case of application for cancellation of admission after one month of admission, but before three months, only Tuition and laboratory fee(only for 3 months) and full examination fee will be refunded.
- (iii) Application for cancellation of admission and for refund of fee, if submitted after three months from the date of admission, shall not be entertained.
- (iv) In case the name of a student is struck off within one month after admission, according to the school rules all the charges will be refunded except the admission fee.

Students Discipline Policy

- ☞ Students must reach school well in time. The attendance of the student should be regular. However, in case of unavoidable circumstances, a leave application has to be sent by the parent along with necessary documents like medical certificate etc.
- ☞ Students must come to school in proper uniform as prescribed in the school diary.
- ☞ **Students are expected to converse only in English.**
- ☞ Students are not supposed to leave the school premises without genuine reason and valid permission of the concerned HM.
- ☞ All the students should have full awareness of personal hygiene. They should maintain proper hair cut / hairdo. Dyeing of hair is not allowed.
- ☞ Students are expected to be social, polite and courteous with their peers and the school staff. They should refrain from arrogant and violent behaviour under all circumstances.
- ☞ The school is for the students. Therefore, every student should have a sense of belonging. He / She must utilize the school facilities like, the school bus, classrooms, libraries, laboratories etc, in a desired manner. No student should cause any damage to the school property. Any such damage caused will be made good by recovering the cost from the student.
- ☞ Students are not supposed to bring to school any material that is not relevant to academics. Possessing undesirable materials, i-Pads, i-Pods, Cameras, CDs, Mobile Phones, Smart Watches, Pen Drives, any objectionable printed material, firecrackers, explosives, etc., would be considered a serious offence and would be confiscated. Appropriate disciplinary action including rustication will be taken based on the seriousness of the offence.

Library

1. Silence should be strictly observed in the library.
2. Students should not bring any book of their own into the library except note books.
3. Students are not allowed to keep any book issued from the library for more than a week; otherwise they are liable to be fined SR.2.00 per day for each book.
4. Students can get the book re-issued for a further period if that book is not in demand.
5. The librarian may call for a book at any time even if the normal period for which the book is issued has not expired.
6. If a book is lost or damaged, the student will have to make good the loss / damage.
7. It is strictly forbidden to tear a leaf, write any remark in a book or to underline the words. If there are already such writings in a book or a leaf is torn, it should be brought to the notice of the librarian immediately on receipt of the book, and not later.
8. Proper care of the library books should be taken.
9. Reference books like dictionary and encyclopedia cannot be taken home. Students can make use of the photocopying facility for the purpose of copying reference material on payment from the xerox room.
10. Students should not exchange library books amongst themselves.

Laboratory

The school has separate laboratories for Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Home Science and Geography. Students should observe the following rules while working in the laboratories:-

1. Follow the instructions given by the teacher and the laboratory assistant.
2. Report any breakage or loss immediately to the teacher in charge.
3. Bring proper record books and observation note books to the laboratory.
4. Hand over the chemicals & apparatus taken for the experiment to the lab assistant.
5. Handle the equipment and chemicals very carefully. (Carelessness in this regard may cause harm / damage to person or the apparatus). The students will be responsible for any breakage or loss of apparatus issued to him/her. If the damage / breakage / loss cannot be immediately fixed individually, a collective fine will be imposed on all the students of the concerned batch / class.

Examination Rules

1. A student is eligible to take the annual examination only if he/she has 75% of attendance, counted from the opening of the academic session up to the last working day of the month preceding the month in which the examination commences.

Shortage of attendance up to 15% may be condoned for classes KG to VIII by the Principal on the recommendation of the concerned H.M. based on valid reasons.

The following may be considered as valid reasons:

- (a) Prolonged illness – supported with medical certificate.
 - (b) Loss of father/mother or some other such incident leading to his/her absence from the school and meriting special consideration.
2. A student is expected to clear all arrears of fee before the final examination.
 3. Students suffering from infectious diseases will not be allowed to attend school or appear for the test /examination.
 4. Students are not permitted to use calculators and other electronic gadgets in the Examination.
 5. Whiteners are not to be used on answer sheets. Any mistake should be scored out and the modified answer separately re-written.
 6. Bringing forbidden material into the examination hall amounts to use of unfair means (UFM).
 7. Writing on the question paper is prohibited and will amount to UFM (except on self-answering question paper).
 8. If a student is found using unfair means during an examination, his/her case will be referred to COE with all relevant supporting evidences which will be further put up to the exam committee for final decision.
 9. Any incident of tampering with examination records will be considered as a serious offence and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.

Promotion Rules

For Classes I-V

1. The school follows the policy of promotion from Class I to Class V subject to the condition that the student puts in the required percentage of attendance in the full academic year.
2. It is required for the students to write the two periodic assessments, Half Yearly and the Annual Examination except for a genuine reason.
3. A student may be retained in the class under any one of the following circumstances:
 - (a) The parents make a special written request that the student should be allowed to repeat the class provided he / she comes under the recommended age group.
 - (b) The class teacher strongly recommends repetition of the class by the child for adequate academic improvement.

For Classes VI-X

Prevailing promotion rules of CBSE will be followed.

For Class XI

1. A student is declared pass if he/she secures a minimum of 33% marks in theory and 33% marks in practical(whenever applicable).
2. Students placed in compartment examination in a subject involving practical work are required to reappear only in the failing portion i.e. either theory or practical in the compartment examination.

Compartment Examination for Class XI

1. Students failing in any **one** subject in class XI will be eligible for compartment examination.
2. Students failing in **two or more subjects** will be detained in the same class.
3. For promotion, a student must secure a minimum of 33% marks in the compartment examination.

Other Information:

- The candidates who have failed or have been detained consecutively twice in (the annual exams of) class VI-IX & XI or who did not appear in the exams, will not be eligible for renewal of the admission.
- The internal students of Class X who have to appear in the compartment exams, have to submit their application forms for Class XI. The students, who pass the compartmental exams with the required percentage of marks, will get the renewal of admission within 10 days after the results are declared. There will be no renewal of admission thereafter.
- The students of Classes X & XII who have been debarred from appearing in the board exams due to shortage of attendance will have to complete the formalities of re-admission for the next academic session by the stipulated date.
- The students who were not allowed to appear in the annual exams due to shortage of attendance should fulfill the formalities of the renewal of admission for the next academic session by the stipulated date.

- Bottom: Plain light blue bloomers of ankle length.
- Black shoes and white socks.
- White hair band / white ribbons / white rubber pony bands.
- Full white uniform on Thursday (design as above)

☞ **Classes I to III (Monday to Thursday)**

- Checked (navy blue and white) blouse, with puffed half sleeves and navy blue pinafore.
- Black shoes and white socks/white stockings.
- White- hair band / white ribbons / white pony bands.

☞ **Classes IV to VIII (Sunday to Thursday)**

- Checked (navy blue and white) Kameez with half sleeves.
- Navy Blue Shalwar and Navy blue Dupatta.
- White hair bands/white ribbons/white pony bands / white scarfs.
- Black shoes and white socks.
- Full white uniform for classes VI-VIII on Mass P.T. days (Mondays).

☞ **Classes IX to XII (Monday to Thursday)**

- Checked (navy blue & white) Kameez with half sleeves.
- White Shalwar (Shalwar bottom 10" circumference) and white Dupatta.
- Plaited hair with white ribbons/ white hairbands / white scarfs. (Open hair not allowed)
- Black shoes and white socks.

☞ **Sundays – Full white uniform for classes – I to V & IX to XII.**

- No jewellery is allowed except small studs and no smart watches are allowed
- White sports shoes on P. T. days and white stockings for classes I, II & III GS

☞ **Winter :**

- Navy blue cardigan / sweater along with the prescribed uniform.(Hoodies/Jackets are not allowed.)

Long black coats for girls in conformity with the law of the land, instead of fancy and flowing abayas which are prone to accidental threats.

- Checked Shirt (Light Blue and White) half sleeves with plain collar and pocket.
- Bottom: Plain light blue quarter length shorts.
- Black shoes and white socks.
- **Thursday** – White Shirt with White Pants. White Shoe and Socks

☞ **Classes I-V (Monday to Thursday)**

- Checked (Navy Blue & White) shirt with half-sleeves and navy blue trousers and school belt.
- Black shoes and white socks.
- **Sunday** – White Shirt, Navy Blue Trousers, White Shoes, White Socks & school belt.

☞ **Classes VI–VIII (Sunday to Thursday)**

- Checked (navy blue and white) shirt with half sleeves and navy blue trousers and black belt.
- Black shoes and white socks.
- On mass P.T. days: White shirt, navy blue trousers, white shoes & white socks.

☞ **Classes IX–XII (Sunday to Thursday)**

- White shirt half sleeves with school logo, navy blue trousers with two pleats and black belt.
- Black Shoes and White Socks.

☞ **Winter (For classes KG to XI)**

- Navy Blue Pullover / Sweater along with the prescribed uniform.

Please note: Low waist trousers are not allowed.

Tips to be a Good Student

- Come to school in a clean and proper uniform. Maintain personal hygiene which will help you remain healthy and confident.
- Be punctual and regular to school.
- Be respectful and obedient to the officials, teachers and other staff of the school.
- Be polite and courteous to your peers.
- Participate in activities organized by the school with a true spirit. At the same time learn to strike a balance between academics and extra-curricular activities.
- Don't move out of the class except during the permitted recess break.
- Keep the classroom, premises and own belongings neat and tidy.
- Flush the toilet after using it and keep the washrooms clean.
- Maintain total discipline in the class and the campus.
- Follow the instructions of teachers and maintain regular study habits.
- Avoid using foul language, playing rough games, quarrelling and fighting in the school campus.
- Develop a spirit of healthy competition and create systematic learning atmosphere in the School.
- Complete the given assignments on time.
- Always revise the work done in the class and seek help from your teachers, friends and parents when you require it.
- Revise at the weekend, all that was learnt during the week.
- Make a daily home time table for yourself. In this way you learn to be a student of regular habits – a most valuable asset in later life.
- Realize the value of time. Do not wait till the onset of tests and examinations. The key to success is regular, timely and sincere work.
- Develop the habit of eating homemade food and exercise regularly. A sound mind and fit body are necessary for a successful life.

A Word to the Parents

Every parent is a 'teacher' to his/her child. International Indian School Jeddah solicits a closer sharing and rapport between teachers and parents for developing the mental and physical faculties of the child so as to help him/her play the rightful role in the society in later years. The faculties of orderliness, discipline, dedication and obedience take root at home and develop further at school. Temperament, disposition, attitude and behaviour have to be moulded by the parents as well as the teachers. To carry out the joint responsibility, the school requests the parents to:

1. Regularly monitor the academic progress of their child and communicate with the concerned teachers through this diary regarding problems if any. If needed, the concerned H.M., VP or the Principal may be contacted.
2. Acknowledge every communication sent by the School by way of notes/circulars.
3. Help the child correct his/her behaviour as and when required.
4. **Ensure that the child is regular and punctual to school.** Always send a leave letter if he/she is absent from school. This will help avoid truancy, as well as, removal of name from the school rolls in case of long absence.
5. **Please don't send your children to school if they are sick.** especially during Tests. Medical Report along with leave application can be submitted later to the Class Teacher.
6. Always pay the fees and other dues on time to avoid embarrassment to the child.
7. Attend all the Parent-Teacher Meetings and get a feedback on the progress of your ward.
8. Ensure that the child is neatly dressed and has all the prescribed books as well as stationery requirements. Do not encourage the habit of borrowing. Teach him/her the value of honesty, integrity and politeness.

9. Ensure that your child wears the ID badge to school every day.
10. **Ensure that children suffering from communicable diseases like Mumps, Measles, Typhoid, Cholera, Chicken pox, etc. do not attend class or the examination till the quarantine period is over. When they resume school a fitness certificate from the hospital should be sent along with the leave note.**
11. Parents are requested not to go to the class rooms for any reason. They should go only to the H.M. who will help them in the matter.
12. Monitor the use of gadgets by your wards. Use of internet and social networking sites and apps should be restricted and monitored.
13. Ensure proper and healthy food habits. Encourage your child to carry home-made food to school.
14. Encourage your ward to participate in the various activities organised by the school. Guide and support them to balance between the scholastic & Co-scholastic activities.
15. Suggestions from parents on improvement of school and welfare of the children are most welcome.
16. In order to ensure the safety and security of your wards, make one fixed transport arrangement for him/her to commute to and from school. Students who commute by school bus should use only the bus to commute to and from school.
17. Parents' contact number is a must and should be available throughout. Latest changes must be updated.
